INFORMATION SHEET

DATES: July 26 - August 4, 2010 (travel, tour from July 21 – August 7, and Jamboree)

TRAVEL: The Long Beach Area Council Jamboree Contingent will tour the east coast preceding the Jamboree. Although tour plans have not been finalized, they most likely will include such places as Arlington National Cemetery, the Smithsonian, Gettysburg, and the Washington DC area.

ORGANIZATION: The Long Beach Area Jamboree Contingent Troop will include 36 Scouts and 4 Adult Leaders who have been selected from various local troops. After our troop has been filled, a standby list of alternates will be established. You will be a member of a patrol within the troop.

REQUIREMENTS: A Scout is only eligible if he holds First Class rank by July 1, 2010; has completed 6th grade or will be at least 12 years old by July 1, 2010; and does not have his 18th birthday before August 3, 2010. His Scoutmaster as well as the local council Jamboree committee must first approve a Scout. Participation in pre-Jamboree training experiences is also mandatory.

TOTAL COST: Estimated at this time: \$3,000 per Scout.

FEE INCLUDES: The Jamboree fee covers all transportation – tour – admission fees – meals – lodging – patrol and troop equipment – National Jamboree fee – and insurance. Your fee also covers the pre-Jamboree training outings. Additional expenses will be your uniforms – personal equipment – and travel money.

REFUND POLICY: If you sign up for the Jamboree and find that you cannot attend, you will receive a refund from the Long Beach Area Council **ONLY** if there is an alternate to take your place.

- The National Jamboree reservation fee - \$100.00 – is not refundable.
- In the event there is not an alternate – a partial refund will be made. This includes the fees you have paid to date – less any expenses related to contractual agreements made on your behalf.
- Deposit fees paid by alternates *not* selected as active participants will be refunded in full.

HOW TO APPLY: Register online at www.MyScouting.org. You must have your BSA member ID number to create a user account. Select "Event Reservations", then "National Scout Jamboree." Complete the on line application and pay the \$10 **nonrefundable**-processing fee. Print the confirmation, have it signed by your Scoutmaster, and take the signed document and \$100 deposit to the Long Beach Area Council. **NOTE:** *This confirmation does not guarantee a spot in a council Jamboree troop. The local council Jamboree committee must interview applicants.*
