



Camp Main Gate

- ↑ 1. Head east on CA-38 E toward Glass Rd — 0.4 mi
- ↶ 2. Turn left onto Glass Rd — 2.2 mi
- ↶ 3. Turn left onto Seven Oaks Rd — 1.5 mi
- ↷ 4. Turn right to stay on Seven Oaks Rd — 292 ft

9 min (4.2 mi)

Destination will be on the left

Camp to Seven Oaks (with 1N09 Option)

As you exit the main camp gate, turn right on Highway 38, and go a half mile to “Glass Road” (there will be a directional sign to "Seven Oaks").

Turn left and go down this paved country road for 2 miles to the bottom of the canyon. You will dead-end on the Santa Ana River Road.

Turn left, and the road goes through some scenic woods, with crossing of the Santa Ana River. There are areas where you can turn off and go down to the river.

After 1.5 miles you will be at the Seven Oaks Resort. It calls itself the “oldest resort in California”, and has a small restaurant, and an even smaller grocery store.

1N09 Option - Continue past Seven Oaks, past apple orchards, crossing the river (nice picnic area). From this point on the road is narrow and unpaved, and recommended for high clearance vehicles only - but the scenery is unbelievable!

Once you get to Highway 38, turn left to get back to camp, or right to go to Angelus Oaks.

Seven Oaks Lodge

Seven Oaks to Angelus Oaks (Narrow dirt road - 4 wheel drive/high clearance vehicles)

- ↑ 5. Head south on Seven Oaks Rd — 1.4 mi
- ↶ 6. Turn left to stay on Seven Oaks Rd — 0.1 mi
- ↷ 7. Turn right onto 1N09/Seven Oaks Rd — 3.2 mi
- ↷ 8. 1N09 turns slightly right and becomes Mill Creek Rd — 0.6 mi
- ↷ 9. Turn right onto CA-38 W — 0.5 mi

Continue to follow 1N09

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
