What: NYLT is a National BSA program providing the highest leadership skills course a Scout can attend at the Council level. Participants practice team and leadership development in a fun and challenging BSA Camp setting that prepares them to serve their home unit as a Senior Patrol Leader, Assistant Senior Patrol Leader, Patrol Leader, or other unit leadership positions. Participating Scouts will work as patrols learning leadership skills and applying those skills in a variety of activities following Lord Baden Powell’s philosophy that Scouting is “fun with a purpose”.

Who: All scouts BSA, Venturing, or Sea Scouts who meet the following requirements:

- Age 13-17 for Scouts BSA, Age 14-20 for OA, Venturing, and Sea Scouts.
- Completed First Class Rank (or equivalent).
- Completed *Introduction to Leadership Skills for Troops/Crews/ or Ships*.
- Have their unit leader’s recommendation.

When: Starting Friday afternoon at 3:00 PM and concluding Sunday evening at 5:00 PM for both weekends, June 21st through 23rd and June 28th through 30th.

Cost: The course fee is \$330. The fee includes all meals, two NYLT activity T-shirts, a neckerchief, patches, a course workbook, and other course materials. All fees must be June 3rd, 2024.

(NYLT) as established by BSA National. If your Scout's unit has not completed this basic leadership training, please reach out to your unit leader or the NYLT course director to learn more about how this training might be completed before attending NYLT.

A Note about Youth Participant age Limits:

NYLT is open to all Scouts who fall within the youth participant age limits for their program. For Scouts BSA this is under the age of 18. For active Order of the Arrow members, Venturing Scouts, and Sea Scouts, this is under age 21. For Scouts BSA members who are 18 or older who still wish to attend NYLT, they can still attend if they are active members of the Order of the Arrow or should consider registering with a Venturing Crew or Sea Scout Ship to maintain their youth member status.
